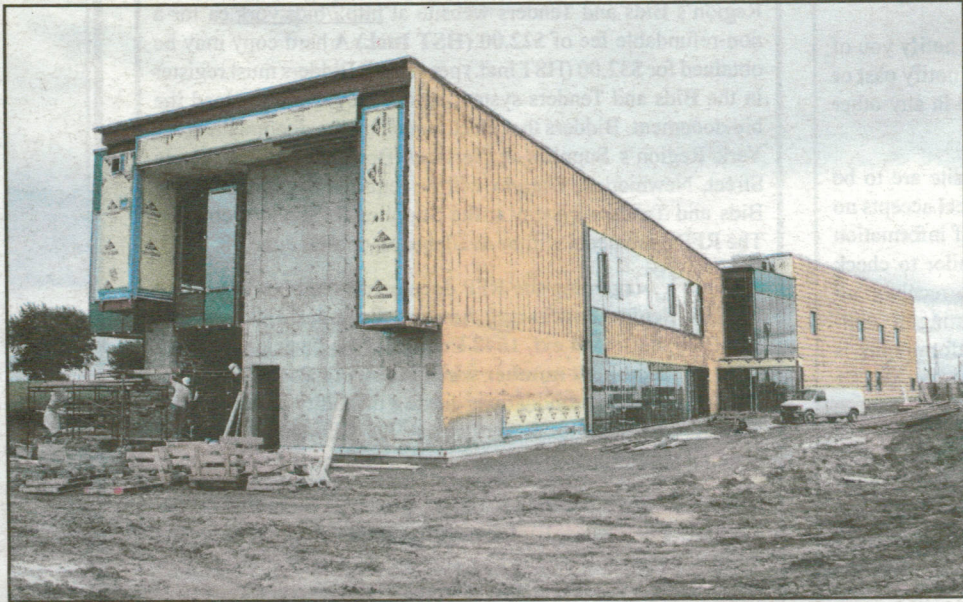


Plant, Prep and Serve

Construction is moving along for the design build of Whitby Phase 3 Expansion - Durham College Centre for Food in Whitby, Ont. The design/builder for the \$18 million, two-storey facility is Garritano Bros Ltd. and completion on the project has been scheduled for mid-August 2013. The owners are Durham College and project manager is MHPM. The centre is a "Field to Fork" design allowing vegetable and fruit gardens on site to be used in the culinary classes and the in-house restaurant. The centre will be equipped with four cooking labs, a restaurant, classroom and faculty space, a culinary school, as well as horticultural and hospitalities programs. The project was designed by Gow Hastings Architects. Consultants are: Stephenson Engineering (structural); MCW (mechanical); DEI (electrical); MMM Group (civil); Cini Little International (food service) and Pinnacle Group (quality control inspections); Green Initiatives (commissioning) and VA Wood Associates/Butler Inspection Group (geotechnical).
